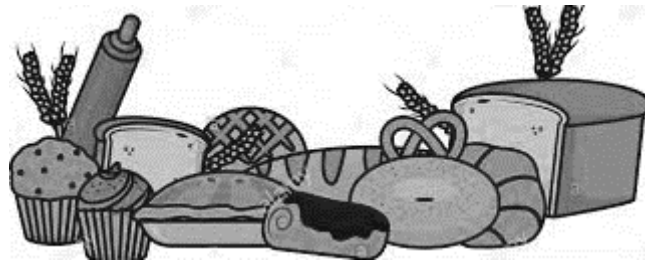


Royal Mile Early Years 2019-20 Newsletter 2
