National Improvement Framework: Priority 1

Raising Attainment in Literacy and Numeracy

- At P1, P4 and P7 standardised scores in literacy and numeracy had improved for most children.
- Last year working with our Cluster and High School Colleagues on writing, this session working on numeracy.
- Getting support from University of Edinburgh maths tutors in P7 and taking part in maths week with Dr Iezzi.
- Review of homework with whole school community to include using IT and creative activities
- Continue to develop writing and spelling across school.

Priority 2: Closing the Attainment Gap between the most and least disadvantaged

- Keeping costs low but making learning rich by using the local environment
- Making sure everyone can come on school trips and residentials
- Having free clubs run by staff that everyone can come to
- Coaching by maths students for all P7 last year
- Offering clubs and drop ins to support home learning

Priority 3: Improvement in Children and young people's Health and Well Being

- Review by children, staff and parents of school's Vision, Values and Aims.
- Healthy snacks and school clothes at affordable costs
- Finding out about SHANARRI
- Continuing the Be Resilient Programme
- Opportunities to try new activities and work with new people from our community

Priority 4: Improvement in Employability and Sustained, positive school leaver destinations for all young people

- Virgin Money make £5 Grow projects across the school and working with local businesses on 'dragon's den' ideas.
- Work with others: universities, art galleries, businesses, local community
