Sometimes I will use hand sanitiser.



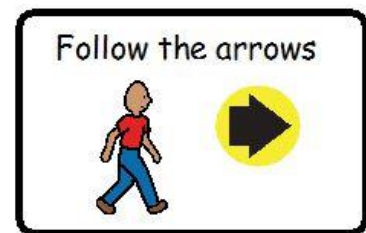
- When entering the school

- When leaving the school



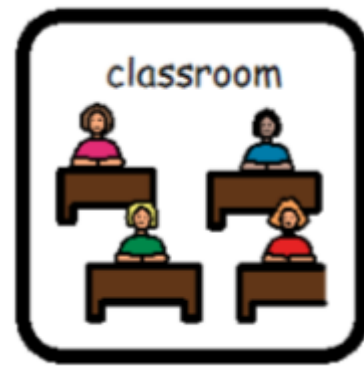
At the start of each day



- I come straight into school from 08.50.
- I come in through the east gate. It is one beside the office.
- There will be an adult from school at the gate
- My parent or carer won't come into the playground with me.
- I follow arrows that show the one way system straight to my classroom.
- I go straight to my own desk with all my belongings.
- These will stay at my desk with me all day.



In Class



- My teacher has made a pack of resources for me to use in class. These will be stored in my tray overnight. These don't not go home. They are yours.



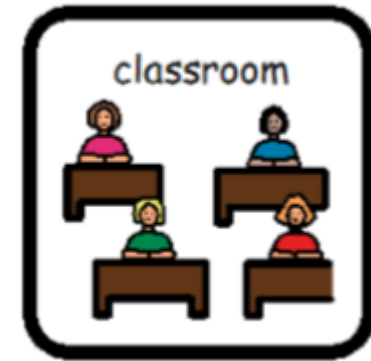
- Use resources from my own pack. I don't share resources. Everyone has the same resources.

- Avoid bringing things from home into school.
- Avoid touching my face.



Lunch

- I eat my lunch in my own classroom at my own desk.
- I wash my hands before and after eating.
- There is 20 minutes to eat your lunch.
- My lunchbox will stay under my desk.
- I will play in a set area of the playground with my own group. It is very important to listen to instructions from the adult in charge.

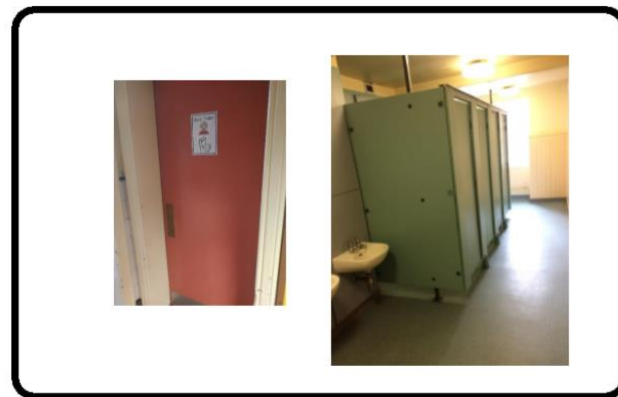


Toilet



- I should go to the toilet before I leave for school.
- During the day, If I need to go to the toilet, I will be accompanied by a member of staff.
- Before break and lunch time I should use the toilet if I need.
- I will not be able to come in to the school building during lunchtime or playtime.

This is the toilets ...



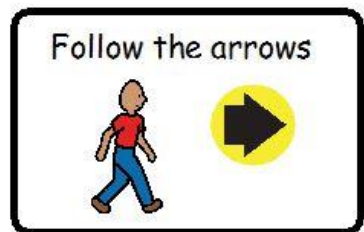
Feeling unwell

- If I wake up coughing a lot or have a high temperature, I should tell an adult at home and not come into school.
- If I feel unwell at school I should tell an adult straight away.
- If you cough or sneeze use a tissue and bin it straight away. I should wash my hands immediately after.
- If I don't have a tissue, I should cough or sneeze into my elbow.



At the end of each day

- I leave through the EAST gate at 3.15pm The door that leads out to the basketball courts and walk round.
- There will be a rolling programme to avoid congestion so please be patient.
- If your adult says you can walk home alone they must let the school know, otherwise you must wait for an adult.
- If parents are meeting you they can't come into the school grounds.
- Once you leave school you can't come back in until the next day. If you have forgotten something you can collect it the next day.
- Teachers will be leaving school too because the school will be being cleaned.
