



P6 Home Learning Week Commencing 26th April 2021

The activities listed in the final column are to be completed at home. **Please note, not all activities must be completed but the expectation is at least one from each curricular area will be done each week.**

Subject	Learning Intention(s)	In Class Activities	To Consolidate at home
Literacy 	-To spell words with the 'hood' suffix. -To find information in a text. -To summarise a text.	This week in class we have been learning to spell words with the 'hood' suffix. We discussed what a suffix is and how these words are nouns. In literacy we have started reading our new class novel on Greek Myths. We looked at the stories of 'In the Beginning and Pandora's Box' and 'Daedalus and Icarus'.	-Write out words with the 'hood' spelling patterns. -Use words with the 'hood' suffix in a sentence. -Read the story of 'Persephone and the Pomegranate Seeds' and summarise the key events.
Numeracy 	-To find fractions of amounts. -To collect data using surveys and questionnaires.	In numeracy this week we were looking at finding fractions of amounts. We learnt that you must divide the total number by the denominator and then multiply by the numerator.	-Choose one sheet from the link below.
