There's a time for work and a time for play.

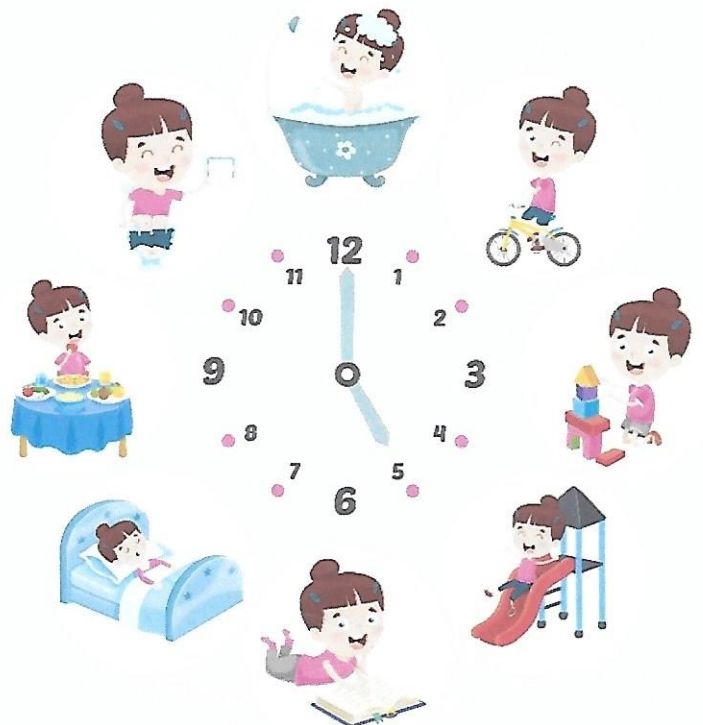
There's a time for sleep at the end of the day.
